174. WIKTORSKI ALLEGATION (VVAW-WSI)

ALLEGATION: 1. Murder of unidentified NVA.
2. Aggravated assault.

SUBJECT/SUSPECTS: Unidentified CO and members of Co C, 2/12th Cav,
1st Air Cav Div.

COMPLAINANT: Mr. Robert Wiktorski, former SP4, Co C, 2/12th Cav, 1st
Air Cav Div.

BACKGROUND: Between 31 Jan and 2 Feb 71, at Detroit, MI, Mr. Wiktorski testified at the "Winter Soldier Investigation" (WSI) as a member of an organization identified as the Vietnam Veterans Against the War (VVAW). Mr. Wiktorski testified to receiving an order (Jun 68) from the CO, which had been passed down by battalion commander, that said, "no prisoners taken, kill all wounded." Wiktorski stated that at Chu Chi base camp, in Jan 69, the CO came to a chow line and told the men to spread out. When they did not the CO "fragged" the line, hitting one man. Wiktorski also alleged that he saw NVA being pushed from a helicopter at LZ Grant near Nui Den (III Corps) in Apr (year not disclosed).

STATUS/PROGNOSIS: Investigation completed; insufficient evidence.

Mr. Wiktorski was interviewed by CID on 4 Aug 71. He refused to make any statement or provide any information concerning his allegations.

WITNESSES: Not identified.

INITIATED BY WHOM: AGC; WSI material is contained in the Congressional Records of 6 and 7 Apr 71.

RESPONSE TO INITIATOR: AGC notified of review and evaluation.
