I. LOCATION

The California - Nevada Regional Office of the VVAW/WSO is located at 255 East Williams Street, San Jose, California.

II. ACTIVITIES

A. National Steering Committee Meeting (NSCM)

A NSCM, VVAW/WSO, was held at Buffalo, New York, August 8-12, 1974. VVAW/WSO delegates from Northern California, in their report to the NSCM, stated the VVAW/WSO, Santa Cruz Chapter, after six months of effort, was given office space in the Veterans Memorial Building and access to Veterans facilities. Its work also includes the Discharge Upgrading Project (DUP) and an information center setting up a veterans switchboard for job referrals and housing.

The delegates also reported the FBI has increased their harassment of the VVAW/WSO members throughout the region. It was stated the FBI is trying to find out "our internal problems and where our members are located". Ongoing education on the FBI and their tactics are being stressed and legal aid is readily available. Delegates also reported that the region had raised \$350 in cash and goods to send people to the District of Columbia demonstration of the VVAW/WSO. The region had good media coverage on several radio stations around the District of Columbia action. The region was also continuing its efforts in the DUP work and the East Bay Chapter has all administrative responsibility for the San Francisco and San Jose area, as well as its own. The region is working on behalf a prison inmate at San Quentin, who is serving several life sentences and recently received another life sentence for involvement in the August, 1970 Marin County Courthouse shootout in which Judge HAROLD HALEY and quards and prisoners, and who was arrested February 6, 1974, in Oakland, California, for assaulting a police officer with a deadly weapon. His trial in February, 1975, resulted in a hung jury and retrial is set for the end of February, 1975.

B. Regional VVAW/WSO Meeting

A VVAW/WSO regional meeting of the California - Nevada Region was held at Santa Cruz, California, September 14-15, 1974. There were approximately 45 - 50 persons present, all from the State of California. Six chapters (five members or more) and three organizing committees (less than five members) had representation present at the meeting. It was stated at the meeting to those present that the San Francisco chapter had ceased as a chapter because of a lack of membership and is now operating as an organizing committee. Individuals from chapters and organizing committees made reports on their activities and projects. Workshops were set up on Indochina, amnesty, Vietnam problems, and racism.

C. Sub-Regional Meeting

A VVAW/WSO sub-regional meeting was held in San Francisco, California, on September 29, 1974. There were approximately 20 persons present. Discussions were held regarding the demonstration at the Federal Office Building, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, which would stress universal unconditional amnesty and veterans should have a retroactive single type discharge. It was also stated that the San Francisco chapter had been dissolved and that its members would like to merge with the Oakland chapter, but this was opposed and it was decided that the San Francisco members could attend Oakland chapter meetings. There were also nominations for national, regional and sub-regional offices.



D. Chapters and Organizing Committees

The Santa Cruz chapter of the VVAW/WSO has approximately 15 members and the treasury has approximately \$100. There were seven meetings between August 15, 1974 and January 21, 1975. At the meeting on August 15, 1974, there was a discussion regarding the non-profit status of the chapter, DUP, circulating of amnesty petitions, and fund-raising projects. (4)



At the chapter meeting September 19, 1974, there was a lengthy discussion on the direction of the VVAW/WSO organization. (C)

At the VVAW/WSO meeting on December 16, 1974, there were discussions on political books for the chapter's office, free speech and self-criticism. (4)

At the January 6, 1975 chapter meeting, there were discussions on the projects to raise funds and a report on the December National Steering Committee meeting at which workshops were set up on mass organizing, wars of imperialist aggression, amnesty, internal organization and democracy. (4) 4

At the January 21, 1975 meeting, a discussion centered around the Revolutionary Union (RU) (see appendix) influence on the VVAW/WSO in the San Francisco area and the organization on a national level. It was stated that within the Santa Cruz chapter, the general consensus is that they do not want any RU members or sympathizers involved in the chapter's activities, and, in general, the San Francisco Bay Area chapters do not want RU members or sympathizers within the organization. The VVAW/WSO members in the San Francisco Bay Area also fear a takeover attempt by the RU people in an effort to control the VVAW/WSO, and the San Francisco Bay Area VVAW/WSO membership is aware of RU influence within the National Steering Committee membership of the VVAW/WSO. Oakland Chapter of the VVAW/WSO

The Oakland chapter has approximately 20 members and \$329 in the treasury. The Oakland chapter of the VVAW/WSO had six meetings between September 12, 1974, and October 10, 1974. It was noted at the September 17, 1974 meeting that the Oakland chapter of the VVAW/WSO is accepting and following Marxism-Leninism and that the chapter is working closely with the national VVAW/WSO headquarters. At the chapter meeting on September 12, 1974, two representatives of the "Prairie Fire" Committee appeared at the VVAW/WSO meeting to promote the publication of "Prairie Fire". They indicated that the "Prairie Fire" Distribution Committee is made up of three sub-committees, namely, mail order, bookstore distribution, and political organizing. (S) U

At the chapter meeting September 19, 1974, there was a discussion regarding the demonstration against President FORD's visit to the San Francisco Bay Area October 2, 1974. It is to be noted that due to the illness of President FORD's wife, he did not appear in the Bay Area, but Vice President NELSON ROCKEFELLER did.

9/20/74

At the chapter meeting on October 3, 1974, there was a discussion on the legal defense of a member arrested, criticism of the ROCKEFELLER demonstration, movies to be shown to raise money, and that the chapter in general is in need of funds. (C) \vee

E. Demonstrations

advised on October 26, 1974, that the subregional VVAW/WSO would hold a demonstration at the Federal Office Building, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, on November 11, 1974 (Veterans Day). Demands for amnesty for deserters and draft evaders from the U. S. Attorney would be stressed.

10/26/74

FBI Agents observed a peaceful demonstration in front of the Federal Office Building, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, on November 11, 1974, sponsored by the VVAW/WSO. Approximately 125 persons picketed in front of the building carrying signs calling for "Unconditional Amnesty Now", "Single Type Discharge Now", and "Decent Benefits for all Veterans".

FBI Agents observed a demonstration sponsored by the VVAW/WSO and other organizations on January 21, 1975, at Union Square, San Francisco, California. Appriximately 300 - 400 persons were present. Speakers at the demonstration stressed alleged violations of the Paris Peace Agreement by the U. S.; support for the Provisional Revolutionary Government in Southeast Asia and the Philippines. The demonstrators carried signs calling for "End All Aid to Thieu and Lon Nal", "Universal Unconditional Amnesty", "Decent Benefits for all Veterans", "Dump Thieu", and "Implement the Peace Agreement".

The VVAW/WSO and other groups sponsored a demonstration at the California State Prison, San Quentin, California, on February 8, 1975. The demonstration was in support of (supra), a prison inmate at San Quentin. Approximately 125 persons took part in the demonstration and carried signs calling for the freedom of

REVOLUTIONARY UNION

The Revolutionary Union (RU), founded in early 1968 in the San Francisco Bay area, is a militant semicovert Marxist-Leninist revolutionary organization ideologically oriented towards the People's Republic of China and the teachings of Chairman MAO Tse-tung. Its objectives as set forth in its theoretical publication, "The Red Papers," and in its monthly newspaper, "Revolution," are the development of a united front against imperialism, the fostering of revolutionary working class unity and leadership in struggle, and the formation of a communist party based on Marxism-Leninism-MAO Tse-tung thought, leading to the overthrow of the United States Government by force and violence. Members of the RU have been identified as collecting weapons while engaging in firearms and guerrilla warefare training. As of July, 1974, RU national headquarters was located in Maywood, Illinois.

VIETNAM VETERANS AGAINST THE WAR/ WINTER SOLDIER ORGANIZATION

A source advised in January, 1974, that the Vietnam Veterans Against the War (VVAW) was organized in New York City in 1967 as an organization of Vietnam Veterans to protest American involvement in the war in Southeast Asia. In 1967-1971, the VVAW engaged in various protest demonstrations of a non-violent nature, but during late 1971 evidenced increasing militancy, culminating in December, 1971, with the takeover of various American landmarks and public buildings. In 1972 certain VVAW leaders were quoted as telling members the VVAW was a revolutionary organization and not "just another group of war veterans."

VVAW leaders have traveled to North Vietnam in 1972-1973 and have reportedly established liaison with revolutionary or terrorist groups internationally. During the January, 1973 National Steering Committee (NSC) meeting, VVAW leaders discussed programs aimed at obtaining support from or influencing active duty military personnel to act contrary to orders. Also discussed was obtaining access to classified Government information to be used against U. S. interests, and one leader subsequently reportedly engaged in such activity.

During 1972, VVAW leaders and activists reportedly made several trips to Europe and Asia during which they participated in conferences with representatives and/or officials of the Soviet Bloc, North Vietnam, and the National Liberation Front of South Vietnam. The membership was also told the VVAW had been asked to cooperate on an international level with many organizations, including communist or Maoist groups, describing them as "our friends". Commitments of support for the VVAW were reportedly received from throughout the world, and it was stated the VVAW had strong ties with nearly all revolutionary organizations. Further, international "anti-imperialist groups" considered the VVAW a potent organization of similar stature in the United States.

At one NSC meeting in 1972, the speakers presented their views in a manner demonstrating the VVAW utilized a Marxist-oriented analysis of world problems.

In April, 1973, an organizational name change to Vietnam Veterans Against the War/Winter Soldier Organization (VVAW/WSO) was made to indicate inclusion as member individuals other than veterans of military service.

During the April, 1973 NSC meeting, the attendees were told the group has communication with over 200 foreign organizations and was considered a credible organization by these groups. In October, 1973, representatives of the VVAW/NSO attended and participated in the World Peace Congress in Moscow, USSR.

In mid-1973 an ideological split within the organizational leadership became evident, with those espousing the Marxist-Leninist doctrine having to contend with the growing influence of the Maoists. Current VVAW/WSO national officers are Marxist-Leninist oriented, and have expressed determination to educate the VVAW/WSO membership in Marxist-Leninist doctrine. The VVAW/WSO publication, "Winter Soldier", is considered a very useful tool in this regard.

The VVAW/WSO is composed of approximately 130 chapters nationwide. Current estimated membership is 2,000. National Headquarters is located at 827 West Newport, Chicago, Illinois.



This investigation is based on information which indicates that VVAW/WSO (see Appendix) is engaged in activities which could involve violations of Title 18, U.S. Code, Sections 2383 (Rebellion or Insurrection), 2384 (Seditious Conspiracy), 2385 (Advocating Overthrow of the Government), 2387 (Sedition), 793 (Espionage), 844 (Explosives and Incendiary Devices), 2155-56 (Sabotage) and 2101 (Antiriot Laws).

ORIGIN OF VVAW/WSO IN AKRON, OHIO

On January 29, 1974 furnished a copy of VVAW/WSO Newsletter #8, dated January 7, 1974, issued by VVAW/WSO Regional Office, P.O. Box 19302, Cincinnati, Ohio, 45219. This newsletter stated "People in the Cleveland-Akron-Elyria-Kent area of northeastern Ohio are invited to an area-wide meeting for those interested in building VVAW/WSO; the meeting is tentatively set for the weekend of the 19th-20th (one of those days) either in Cleveland or Akron. Mike Carmedy of the Akron chapter (address: 92 Bittman, Akron, Ohio, 44303; phone 216-762-7722 - call before noon or after 8:00 PM), is making arrangements for the meeting; you can get the details from him". MEMBER OF SUBJECT ORGANIZATION

The newsletter further stated "A growing Akron chapter is being organized by Mike Carmedy; study groups have been started and VVAW/WSO is being built through work in factories".

AIMS AND PURPOSES

During the period of February 7, 1974 to February 3, 1975, and advised on several occasions that the Akron chapter of VVAW/WSO had participated in or hosted meetings of the VVAW/WSO region which included representation of chapters from Ohio, Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan, Western Pennsylvania and West Virginia.

On March 3, 1975 advised that the Akron chapter of VVAW/WSO is supposed to take up National VVAW/WSO programs, but this chapter has actually done little about the national program. The chapter is involved in studying of a theoretical rather than an activist nature. The chapter's President, once stated he wanted to "get something going with the police and get them to make a mistake". Source advised that specific intentions in this regard were never clarified by him, but he cited the case of a local officer who shot someone on a drug arrest in Portage County, Ohio, in 1974 and the issue of police repression this raised.


further advised that some members of the Akron chapter give the impression that if violence came about, they would welcome it and use it as a tool.

Source described chapter President as being highly unstable, as evidenced by his tantrums at the least provocation. Source indicated that, based on desire to "get something going with the police" that he would like to incite violence.







VIETNAM VETERANS AGAINST THE WAR/ WINTER SOLDIER ORGANIZATION

The VVAW was formed in 1967 as an organization of Vietnam veterans to protest American involvement in the war in Southeast Asia. Since that time VVAW leaders have told members the VVAW is a revolutionary group, not "just another group of war veterans". Also, the membership has been told the VVAW has been asked to cooperate on an international level with many organizations, including communist and Maoist groups. Additionally, it was indicated that "anti-imperialist groups" consider the VVAW a potent organization of similar stature in the U.S. In April, 1973, the group changed their name to VVAW/WSO so that non-veterans could become members. Current VVAW/WSO national officers are Marxist-Leninist oriented and strive to educate their membership in Marxist-Leninist doctrine.







VIETNAM VETERANS AGAINST THE WAR/ WINTER SOLDIER ORGANIZATION

A source advised in January, 1974, that the Vietnam Veterans Against the War (VVAW) was organized in New York City in 1967 as an organization of Vietnam Veterans to protest American involvement in the war in Southeast Asia. In 1967-1971, the VVAW engaged in various protest demonstrations of a non-violent nature, but during late 1971 evidenced increasing militancy, culminating in December, 1971, with the takeover of various American landmarks and public buildings. In 1972 certain VVAW leaders were quoted as telling members the VVAW was a revolutionary organization and not "just another group of war veterans."

VVAW leaders have traveled to North Vietnam in 1972-1973 and have reportedly established liaison with revolutionary or terrorist groups internationally. During the January, 1973 National Steering Committee (NSC) meeting, VVAW leaders discussed programs aimed at obtaining support from or influencing active duty military personnel to act contrary to orders. Also discussed was obtaining access to classified Government information to be used against U. S. interests, and one leader subsequently reportedly engaged in such activity.

During 1972, VVAW leaders and activists reportedly made several trips to Europe and Asia during which they participated in conferences with representatives and/or officials of the Soviet Bloc, North Vietnam, and the National Liberation Front of South Vietnam. The membership was also told the VVAW had been asked to cooperate on an international level with many organizations, including communist or Maoist groups, describing them as "our friends". Commitments of support for the VVAW were reportedly received from throughout the world, and it was stated the VVAW had strong ties with nearly all revolutionary organizations. Further, international "anti-imperialist groups" considered the VVAW a potent organization of similar stature in the United States.

At one NSC meeting in 1972, the speakers presented their views in a manner demonstrating the VVAW utilized a Marxist-oriented analysis of world problems.

APPENDIX

In April, 1973, an organizational name change to Victnam Veterans Against the War/Winter Soldier Organization (VVAW/WSO) was made to indicate inclusion as member individuals other than veterans of military service.

During the April, 1973 NSC meeting, the attendees were told the group has communication with over 200 foreign organizations and was considered a credible organization by these groups. In October, 1973, representatives of the VVAW/NSO attended and participated in the World Peace Congress in Moscow, USSR.

In mid-1973 an ideological split within the organizational leadership became evident, with those espousing the Marxist-Leninist doctrine having to contend with the growing influence of the Maoists. Current VVAW/WSO national officers are Marxist-Leninist oriented, and have expressed determination to educate the VVAW/WSO membership in Marxist-Leninist doctrine. The VVAW/WSO publication, "Winter Soldier", is considered a very useful tool in this regard.

The VVAW/WSO is composed of approximately 130 chapters nationwide. Current estimated membership is 2,000. National Headquarters is located at 827 West Newport, Chicago, Illinois.

A Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) observed the participants in the demonstration as they walked in a small circle on the sidewalk at the entrance to the building. The demonstrators passed out leaflets to people passing by. The leaflet identified the demonstrators as supporting the VVAW/WSO, Columbus, Ohio Chapter, the sponsor of the demonstration, called on the Second Anniversary of the Paris Accords to spotlight their demand for the end of all United States aid to Saigon and Pnom-Penh.

The leaflet stated the VVAW/WSO chose the site:

APPENDIX

VIETNAM VETERANS AGAINST THE WAR/ WINTER SOLDIER ORGANIZATION (VVAW/WSO)

The VVAW was formed in 1967 as an organization of Vietnam veterans to protest American involvement in the war in Southeast Asia. Since that time VVAW leaders have told members the VVAW is a revolutionary group, not "just another group of war veterans." Also, the membership has been told the VVAW has been asked to cooperate on an international level with many organizations, including communist and Maoist groups. Additionally, it was indicated that "anti-imperialist groups" consider the VVAW a potent organization of similar stature in the U.S. In April, 1973, the group changed their name to VVAW/WSO so that non-veterans could become members. Current VVAW/WSO national officers are Marxist-Leninist oriented and strive to educate their membership in Marxist-Leninist doctrine.
