> The National Peace Action Coalition was founded in 1970 by members of the Socialist Workers Party (SWP). Its basic objective is to unite masses of people including labor unions, GIs, and the black community in the struggle to end United States intervention in Southeast Asia through orderly and peaceful tactics. The SMP has been designated pursuant to Executive Order 104504

The Vietnam Veterans Against the War (VVAW) was founded in the Spring of 1967 by six young Vietnam veterans in New York City. At the beginning of 1968, with 600 members, VVAW opened a national office. founded the first GI newspaper 'Vietnam GI", and sent close to 500 veterans into the McCarthy campaign to beat down the

STUDENT MOBILIZATION COMMITTEE, aka Student Mobilization Committee to End the War in Vietnam; National Student Mobilization Committee

A source advised on May 16, 1969, that the Student Mobilization Committee (SMC) originally grew out of the National Student Strike for Peace Conference held in Chicago, Illinois, on December 28-29, 1966, which resulted in a call for massive anti-war demonstrations in New York City and San Francisco, Cali-war demonstrations in New York City and San Francisco, Cali-war demonstrations in New York City and San Francisco, Cali-war fornia, on April 15, 1967. The National Student Strike for Peace Conference was originally called by the Communist Party (CP) and the Socialist Workers Party (SWP), culminating in a takeover by the SWP element in the Summer of 1968 and the CP element withdrawing. Source further advised that the SMC localizand nationally is controlled by the SWP and its youth arm, the Young Socialist Alliance (YSA), as evidenced by the YSA leadership and participation in SMC activities.

The SWP has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

A report of the Committee on Un-American Activities, House of Representatives, Ninetieth Congress, First Session, dated March 31 1967, entitled "Communist Origin and Manipulation of Vietnam Weel (April 8-15, 1967)," on page 53, states in part, "Communists are playing dominant roles in both the Student Mobilization Committee and the Spring Mobilization Committee."

A second source advised on November 16, 1970, that the New York Regional Office of the SMC was located at 15 East 17th Street, Second Floor, New York, New York, where "The Student Mobilizer" is published. "The Student Mobilizer" is self-eescribed as being published by the National Office of the Student Mobilization Committee to End the War in Vietnam. Source stated that the program of the SMC continues as follows: immediate and uncondition; withdrawal of all United States Troops from Vietnam, an end to draft, an end to all forms of campus complicity with the war in Vietnam, self-determination for Vietnam and black America, and Constitutional rights for GIs and high school students.

A third source advised on February 16, 1971, that as of that dat the National Office of the SMC was located at 1029 Vermont Ave., N.W., Eighth Floor, Washington, D. C. 20005.

### YOUNG SOCIALIST ALLIANCE

The May, 1960, issue of the "Young Socialist" (YS), Page 1, Column 3, disclosed that during April 15-17, 1960, a national organization entitled, "The Young Socialist Alliance" (YSA) was established at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. This issue stated that this organization was formed by the nationwide supporter clubs of the publication YS.

The above issue, page 6, set forth the Founding Declaration of the YSA. This declaration stated that the YSA recognizes the Socialist Workers Party (SWP) as the only existing political leadership on class struggle principles, and that the supporter of the YS have come into basic political solidarity with the SWP on the principles of revolutionary socialism.

On March 10, 1967, a source advised that the YSA was formed during 1957, by youth of various left socialist tendencies, particularly members and followers of the SWP. The source further advised that the YSA has recently become more open about admitting that it is the youth group of the SWP and that an SSP representative has publicly stated that the YSA is the EWP's you group.

The National Headquarters of the YSA are located in Room 532-53.

On October 31, 1967, a second source advised that at the 23nd National Convention of the SWP held in New York City from October 26, 1967, to October 29, 1967, it was stated that the YSA remains the main recruiting ground for new SWP members.

The SWP has been designated pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

NON AVAILABILITY OF A SUITABLE BED IS NOT AN ACCEPTABLE REASON FOR REFUSING ADMISSION. ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS WHO INQUIRE ABOUT TREATMENT FOR DRUG DEPENDENCE WILL BE ENCOURAGED TO ACCEPT HOSPITALIZATION. ANY DIFFICULTY IN EFFECTING TRANSPER WILL BE REPORTED TO THE APPROPRIATE REGIONAL MEDICAL DIRECTOR BY TELEPHOTE. USUAL ASMRO PROCEDURES REMAIN IN EFFECT.
- 13. From Italy. The G.I. movement in the Italian Army is growing. They face the same oppression that G.I.s around the world face. The present trend is towards coffeehouses similar to those organized in this country several years ago.





On April 23, 1969, the U.S. From U.S. Army Intelligence Command. Army Intelligence Command at Fort Holabird, Md., issued a secret "Information Collection Plan", directing agents from 300 MI offices in the U.S. to intensify surveillance of civilian activity. Agents were specifically ordered to place under surveillance all strikes and labor disputes, all antiwar and antidraft activities, all demonstrations, rallies, parades, marches, conventions, conferences and picketing act-Extensive photo-coverage of all activities, including the use of telephoto lens, will be made. Identification are to be made of all personalities involved, or expected to become involved in protest activities and to obtain information on the extent of overt and/ or covert financing. The reports must include the identification of participating organizations, number of people each can mobilize, details concerning transportation arrangements and housing facilities for non-local visiting demonstrators, any indication of foreign influence, and any extremist whose background indicated military training in guerrilla warfare, counterinsurgency or use of explosives and demolitions. This document is available at the U.S. Army Investigative Records Repesitory or at your local underground newspaper.

At the beginning of 1968, with 600 members, VVAW opened a national office, founded the first GI newspaper, Vietnam GI", and sent close to 500 members of the Market City. sent close to 500 veterans into the McCarthy campaign to beat down the red baiters. After getting gassed at the Democratic convention at Chicago and caught in the general "down" of the peace movement, VVAW was nearly inactive until the moratoriums in the fall of 1969. Members of VVA led student strikes on major campuses across the country and battled Veterans Administration Hospital authorities over threats to throw amputee Vietnam veterans out for signing anti-war petitions. At present membership of t VVAW, mationally, consists of 8,500 members.







> The Vietnam Veterans Against the War (VVAW) was founded in the Spring of 1967 by six young Vietnam veterans in New York City. At the beginning of 1968, with 600 members, VVAW opened a national office, founded the first GI newspaper "Vietnam GI", and sent close to 500 veterans into the MC CARTHY campaign to beat down the red baiters. After getting gassed at the Democratic Convention in Chicago and caught in the general "down" of the peace movement, VVAV was nearly inactive until the moratoriums in the Fall of 1969. Members of the VVAV led student strikes on major campuses across the country and battled Veterans Administration Hospital authorities over threats to throw amputee Vietnam veterans out for signing anti-war petitions. At present membership of the VVAV/na donally consists of 8,500 members
